## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

- 1. Clinical practice will be done between 19<sup>th</sup> of July 2021 and 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2021.
- 2. The aims of the summer practice for the 1<sup>st</sup> year are focused on the student's becoming familiar with the way of organization and functioning of the medical facilities, as well as with the attributions of the medical staff.
- 3. The standard of knowledge is minimal and compulsory.
- 4. It is recommended that the practice may be made in general medicine or medical/surgical offices, hospital clinical departments or emergency services.
- 5. The practice will be carried on under the supervision of a specialist or medical doctor who will certify that by signature and stamp.
- 6. Students will upload their internship certificate on the Moodle platform between 01-02.09.2021. The practice training will be evaluated through an online test between 02-03.09.2021, at the date and time set by the internship tutor.

## 1<sup>st</sup> Year Practice Standard

- 1. The hospital / medical office's patient circuitry.
- 2. Patient rights and obligations. Informed consent.
- 3. Medical hands washing with water and soap / disinfectant soap. Hands washing with alcoholic solutions.
- 4. Patient monitoring (temperature, pulse, breathing, diuresis, stool, vomiting, sputum).
- 5. Non-invasive medical measurement of blood pressure.
- 6. Venous blood collection.
- 7. Capillary glycaemia measurement.
- 8. Oral and inhalation medication administration.
- 9. Intramuscular injection.
- 10. Subcutaneous injection.
- 11. Assisting the patient during bedside positioning and walking through the ward.
- 12. Medical positioning of the patient in the hospital bed.
