



### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

1. Clinical practice will be done between 19<sup>th</sup> of July 2021 and 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2021.
2. The aims of the summer practice for the 1<sup>st</sup> year are focused on the student's becoming familiar with the way of organization and functioning of the medical facilities, as well as with the attributions of the medical staff.
3. The standard of knowledge is minimal and compulsory.
4. It is recommended that the practice may be made in general medicine or medical/surgical offices, hospital clinical departments or emergency services.
5. The practice will be carried on under the supervision of a specialist or medical doctor who will certify that by signature and stamp.
6. Students will upload their internship certificate on the Moodle platform between 01-02.09.2021. The practice training will be evaluated through an online test between 02-03.09.2021, at the date and time set by the internship tutor.

### **4<sup>th</sup> Year**

#### **Practice Standard**

1. Medical/Surgical hands washing with water and soap / disinfectant soap. Hands washing with alcoholic solutions.
2. Patient monitoring (temperature, pulse, breathing, diuresis, stool, vomiting, sputum).
3. Administration of parenteral therapy (intramuscular, subcutaneous, intravenous) specific to the hospital ward/medical service where the medical practice is being carried out.
4. Wound decontamination and dressing.
5. Performs the anamnesis and objective clinical examination of patients admitted in the hospital ward/medical service.
6. Recognizes the main types of medical-surgical emergencies in patients admitted in the hospital ward/medical service.
7. Presents the presumptive diagnoses to the coordinator and recommends paraclinical investigations for patients admitted.
8. Presents to the coordinator the suggested therapeutic plans for patients admitted in the hospital ward/medical service.
9. Drafting a medical prescription.
10. Communication with the patient regarding the effects of medication.
11. Cardio-respiratory resuscitation
12. Pleural, pericardial and abdominal puncture and drainage
